Terms of Reference

RM/City Recreation Board Representatives – Terms of Reference

Dated – March 16, 2020

1. Purpose
  - a. The RM of Meadow Lake and the City of Meadow Lake neighbor each other;
  - b. Each municipality has either infrastructure or equipment that may be shared from time to time;
  - c. The regional representatives will meet on a regular basis to better acquaint each other on the strengths and weakness of the programs and review how they can help each other to better serve the communities for which they represent.
2. Key Duties and Responsibilities
  - a. Meet with the City of Meadow Lake;
  - b. Review the needs (financial and/or infrastructure) of the Recreational facilities and how the RM may help to better the needs of the RM ratepayers through assistance to the Recreational facilities
3. Level of Authority
  - a. The regional representatives have no authority to approve any decisions made at this level.
4. Reporting
  - a. Reports shall be brought to Council, in writing, for review
  - b. If a decision is required from the RM Council, then a Request for Decision shall be presented to the Council as a whole.
5. Composition and Appointments
  - a. Regional Recreation Representatives
    - i. RRR shall be the liaison to meet with the City of Meadow Lake
      1. This is **NOT** the RM of Meadow Lake Recreation Board who meet for the Community Grants Program.
    - ii. Shall consist of:
      1. CAO
      2. Reeve
      3. One Councillor appointed every 2 years
      4. One Member at large from the RM of Meadow Lake Community as appointed yearly by the RM of Meadow Lake Council.
6. Meetings
  - a. Shall be on a “as need” basis and will be called by the CAO for the RM of Meadow Lake and/or City Manager for the City of Meadow Lake
