Policy Title: Dust Suppressant Application

Policy Objective: To describe the allowable use of Dust Suppressant on Rural Roads as well as authorizing agents to act on behalf of Council	
Authority: Council Resolution #274/16	Dated: November 13, 2018

Background:

1. The Council for the RM of Meadow Lake #588 are responsible for the safety of the travelling public on road allowances and must approve an activities that may happen beyond the Municipalities operations.
2. Ratepayers within the RM of Meadow Lake #588 are interested in applying a Dust Suppressant product along the roadway in front of homes, business' and other properties.

Policy:

1. The Administrator, along with consultation with the Manager of Public Works has the approval to approve Dust Suppressant on roads within the RM of Meadow Lake as follows:
 - a. All applications for Dust Suppressant must be completed in writing to the RM of Meadow Lake office (see Schedule A – Application for Dust Suppressant;
 - b. Applicants must provide information as to:
 - i. Location of road for application (ie: Township/Range Road)
 - ii. Name of Company or Individual completing the Application
 - iii. Name and type of Product being placed on the road.
 1. Must be approved by Sask. Environmental standards
2. The RM of Meadow Lake #588 will NOT pay for any application of Dust Suppressant Product unless it directly affects the operations of the Municipality.
3. Applicants will be reminded that the dust suppressant product may disappear in the maintenance operations of the Municipality. If the product is placed on a road which is regularly scheduled for grader maintenance, the Operator will continue the regular schedule.
4. Applicant will be solely liable for any legal action resulting from application of dust suppressant
